| PHASE 2: NEW LEARNING | Introduce learners to their reading material, Allow learners to glance through and analyze it carefully. What is the title of the book? What stories does the book contain? Are the stories drama, narrative, poetry or prose? Put learners into groups for them to read the text. Model the poem by reading it line by line. Ask learners to follow as you read. Make sure you stress the important words and pause often to see if learners are following. Make sure you put some extra stress on the rhyming words. Ask learners to work in pairs. Tell them to practice all the verses of the poem, paying attention to the stress, the punctuation and rhyming words.
