| PHASE 2: <b>MAIN</b>  | Write learners responds and discuss with them.  E 2: MAIN  Brainstorm on the meaning of substance abuse.  Taking drugs without medical prescription or excessive use of drugs.  In groups, learners discuss and identify the types of substances abused.  • The abuse of legal drugs — Paracetamol, Tramadol, Benylin, antacid, tobacco, Alcohol, etc.  • The abuse of illegal drugs — cocaine, heroin, cannabis, hashish, etc.  Divide the class into three groups. Let each group identify and discuss one of the classification of drugs that are abused and their effects.  Hallucinogens — marijuana(wee or Indian hemp)  Stimulants — caffeine, Nicotine, cocaine, Amphetamines.  Depressants — alcohol, barbiturates, tranquilizers, Narcotics.
