Let them discuss the creation story. Each group presents their findings to the class. Example: THE AKAN MYTH ON CREATION The Akans are the largest ethnic group in Ghana. They include, the Assins, Ashantis, Akims, Aowin, Adansis and Fantes. They believe that creation took the following ways: 1. God, called "Onyankopon" created all the things on the earth and in heaven in definite manner and order. 2. Onyankopon created the sky, water bodies, plants and minerals one after the other to fill the land and heaven. etc THE EWE MYTH ON CREATION The Ewes are largely found in the Volta Region of Ghana. They believe that creation took the following form: 1. God, called "Mawu" created everything on the earth and in heaven. 2. Before He created everything, the world was without form. It was completely dark, etc. Learners in groups describe the naming ceremonies in the three major religions. Guide learners to discuss the importance of naming ceremonies.						cures and
