Draw two circles with the same diameter at each end of the lines. Connect the circle synth a curved line to create a cylinder. 6. Cone: Draw a circle and draw a straight line from the centre of the circle to its circumference. Cut out a sector of the circle by drawing two straight lines from the endpoints of the first line to the circle. Join the two straight lines at their endpoints to create a cone
